<b>One Day Workshop on MBA-CET Preparation by RIT.(Under MOU Activity) (27-2-2023)</b>	
<p>One Day Workshop on MBA-CET Preparation organized on behalf of Accountancy Association on 27-2-2023. Total 30 students were attended the programme. .This programme was organized under the MOU under the Rajarambapu Institute of Technology. Dr. S.H.Ambawade introduced about the programee and explained the objectives about the programme. She expressed that MBA CET, is a state-level management entrance test held in the state of Maharashtra by the State Common Entrance Test Cell. The test is conducted for admission to full-time postgraduate courses such as MBA (Masters in Business Administration). There are usually a total of 200 objective-type questions, and each one contains five alternatives. According to the marks distribution, answering each question right gives one mark to the candidate, whereas there is no negative marking. The language of the examination is English. The MBA CET Syllabus is comparable to MBA exams like the CAT,</p>	



SNAP, and XAT, featuring questions from four sections: abstract reasoning, logical reasoning, quantitative aptitude, and verbal ability. Dr. K.S.Patil invited as a resource person for the first session, which is related to the CET syllabus, Logical reasoning and abstract Reasoning. He explained the exam pattern that the MBA CET test is administered in an online format for 150 minutes. The Maharashtra CET includes

- Multiple-choice questions
- The language of the question paper in English
- The exam has a total of 200 points.
- Students are given one mark for answering each question right.
- There is no penalty for incorrect responses.
- The computer-based online exam booklet has a total of 200 questions.

Further he explained that after the successful registration and fee payment, candidates must complete the MBA CET application procedure completely.

The MBA CET Syllabus includes

- Logical reasoning - Statement Conclusion, Syllogism, Blood Relation, Directions, Data Sufficiency, Seating Arrangement, Coding-Decoding
- Quantitative aptitude - Ratio and Proportion, Percentage, Quantitative Reasoning, Interpretation of tables, common graphs, and charts
- Verbal ability - Grammar, Vocabulary, Sentence Completion, Synonyms, Antonyms, Comprehension of passages
- Abstract reasoning - Non-Verbal Reasoning, Venn diagrams, Odd one out, standalone questions on topics of logical and critical reasoning

The resource person for the second session was Shri Sanket Singh. He guided to the students on Verbal reading, comprehension and quantitative analysis. He solved some numerical and verbal reading question by taking the help of students. Principal Dr.V.A.Mane expressed in the precedential remark, that MAH MBA CET exam is a moderately difficult exam and one can score well if the preparation is done well. To prepare for MAH CET MBA exam candidates must follow a preparation pattern. Mrs S.T.Biranje proposed the vote of thanks.
