

Detailed Report:

A one-day International Conference on 'Advanced and Innovative Practices in Commerce and Management, Science and Technology, Humanities, Languages and Their Role In Achieving The Exponential Growth' was organized by ant at Shri Venkatesh Mahavidyalaya, Ichalkaranji Dist: Kolhapur, (Maharashtra) on 16th February, 2019 in collaboration with Shivaji University Commerce and Management Teachers Association

(SUCOMATA) and Bharati Vidyapith Deemed University's Institute of Management and Entrepreneurship Development (IMED), Pune, as knowledge partners.
