


Introduction:

2)Difficulty level of the curriculum is suitable to students' knowledge group. 20 responses




3) Curriculum includes sufficient practical components. 20 responses

4)Curriculum provides scope for planning co-curricular activities. 20 responses



5)Semester duration is sufficient in teaching the components of curriculum. 20 responses




6) Components of the curriculum provide you opportunities in inculcating civic responsibilities among students.



7)Content of the curriculum is interesting to be taught in the classroom. 20 responses




8) There are sufficient library resources relevant to curriculum. 20 responses






9)Curriculum is designed so as to develop students' employability skills. 20 responses





10)Curriculum demands more use of ICT based teaching. 20 responses




11) Components of the curriculum correspond to the objectives and outcome of the Programme (B.Com / B.B.A/ M. Com etc.).








13) There is a comfortable academic ambience in the institution. 20 responses

 - 1) Reduce the other activity and Promote to practical activities.

2) Some changes in syllabus particularly accounting

- More number of points related to industry requirements should be added in syllabus.
- The number of reference books related to syllabus should be increased in the library.
- 5) Skill based curriculum syllabus should design employment oriented .
- 6) The curriculum should be according to current affairs and social, political and economic changes taking place over time.
- 7) The syllabus should include technology, current affairs, practical knowledge.
- 8) Need to use annual pattern instead of semester pattern.

Conclusion: As the graphic presentation shows most of the faculty members are satisfied with the syllabi they have undertaken to teach. Certain faculty members have expressed the need of adding more practical components in the curriculum of their subjects whereas certain others have highlighted the lack of time they get to teach in the semester pattern and have expressed a need of having annual pattern. The student teacher ratio is also one of the concerns expressed by the teachers. The suggestions and interferences sought from the graphic presentation will be communicated to the concerned authority.
