### **Programme Details**

- Mentees has been assigned to the mentors right from the first year of programme.
- ❖ A mentor has to call the two meeting in the each term
- The mentees preferably be attached to the same mentor for the entire duration of the programme.
- The mentor shall meet the mentees regularly and record the outcome of the meeting in the hard copy. The details about each mentee will be recorded and periodically updated.
- The mentor shall identify the students' performance in curricular or co-curricular activities and report to the head of the institution/department for providing further motivation to advanced/ slow learners.
- The mentor shall also identify the students whose attendance is below as per set standard or norms of college (75% to 80%).
- The mentor shall interact with the student and try to find out the cause of the problem or an indifferent behavior.
- ❖ If required the mentor will involve the parents, head of the department for reforming the student.
- \* The mentor shall observe and monitor the attendance of the mentee.
- Mentor shall advise and take necessary follow up action with regard to students who do not meet the attendance norms of the college.
- The mentor shall also keep a record of the academic performance of mentees including continuous assessment, term examination and help the mentee through counselling or by arranging remedial teaching,
- Mentor should inculcate Behavioral and discipline matters
- Mentor should handle the Stress related issues

#### **Duties/Responsibilities of Mentor**

- 1. Introduce and discuss the concept of mentor- mentee system with the assigned mentees.
- 2. Call a meeting of all mentees and record their necessary details in the designated form.
- 3. Note any specific requirement of a students and discuss with them the complete schedule of future meetings.
- 4. Discuss the students about syllabus, exam pattern, going on courses run under lifelong department, syllabus completion etc.
- 5. Keep a track of the attendance, academic performance and behavioural aspects of the students by interacting with exam department
- 6. Support students academically and emotionally
- 7. Contact to parents in the teacher parent meeting and to inform the progress of their ward.
- 8. Maintain a record of the progress made by the identified underperforming students and take remedial actions wherever required.
- 9. To guide students and also to arrange for remedial teaching if required.

10. To maintain the Email id and PRN record of the students.

# **Duties/Responsibilities of Mentee**

- 1. Attend meeting regularly
- 2. Fill personal information in the form at the time of joining the mentor- mentee system.
- 3. To attend the continuous Internal Exam, to attend the programme on cocurricular, extra-curricular activities.
- 4. To maintained the discipline in the college.
- 5. To attend the classes regularly.
- 6. To fill up the exam form, scholarship forms, feedback form, anti-ragging form as per schedule provided by university or college.
- 7. To provide the academic and personal information to the college whenever necessary.
- 8. To complete the courses provided by the college for skill development of the students.
