REPORT ON STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY, 2019-20

From the Academic year 2018-19, with the initiatives of IQAC the institution started to conduct the Students Satisfaction Survey as one of the measuring parameters of quality education of the college. In the academic year 2019-20, the institution planned to do this survey online. On the basis of the questionnaire provided by NAAC for the Students Satisfaction Survey, the institute has formed its own questionnaire in bilingual form (Marathi and English).

In the academic year 2019-20 offline as well as online Students Satisfaction Survey was conducted by the Feedback Committee of the college by separately opening the email account for both online feedback and satisfaction survey. The offline survey was conducted at the middle of the first semester in which 202 students provided their responses. The online survey was conducted during the period of 11 March 2020 to 3rd May 2020 for which 364 students registered their responses. Thus in total 566 responses have been analyzed for the survey. The data of the responses is provided as follows:
